UTIC Recent Accomplishments

- 20 Projects offered via Round 3 RPP (FY19-02), issued on 14 June 2019
- 16 Projects offered via Round 4 RPP (FY20-01), issued on 15 October 2019
- 27 Projects awarded to date; 24 awardees; \$222M; 72 Proposals in basket
- 269 UTIC members from 35 states
- Membership is comprised of 74% nontraditional organizations with 67 large businesses, 186 small businesses, 4 not-for-profit and 12 academic organizations

UTIC was awarded the OTA from the Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) in early June 2018. It is for three years with options for up to 10 years.
