Key Accomplishments



Milestones since UTIC OTA Award in 2018

- Over 70 prototype projects awarded, accounting for over \$450 million, with ~100 proposals in the basket
- ~300 UTIC members across 33 states
- Membership comprised of 71% non-traditional organizations, with 175 small businesses, 65 large businesses, 6 non-profits and 10 academic organizations



Opportunities

Access to best-in-class expertise and, through Other-Transaction-Agreements (OTA), exposure to Navy research and development.

Prototype possibilities for non-traditional companies. OTA has opened up over 450M worth of opportunities to help bring technology to market.

72 prototype project awards: 37 to small businesses, 30 to large businesses, and 5 to academic institutions. All awards have significant participation by non-traditional contractors.
